CERAMIC CLASSES



BEGINNING WHEEL 1.0

This class is an 8 week introduction to working with clay on the pottery wheel. Each student will have their own wheel to work with. You will learn basic throwing techniques and explore the cup and cylinder. *This class is for individuals with little to no experience.* Monday evenings 6-8 pm.

BEGINNING WHEEL 2.0

This class is an 8 week introduction to working with clay on the pottery wheel. Each student will have their own wheel to work with. Students will refresh and refine their basic wheel throwing skills, while developing their individual style. *This class is intended for beginners to expand on their basic knowledge and continue to develop their throwing skills.* Thursday evenings 6-8 pm.

INTERMEDIATE WHEEL:

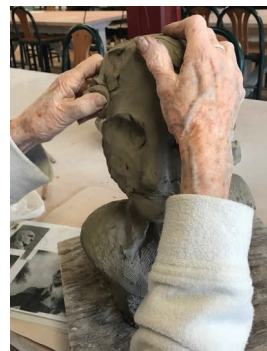
This 8 week class is focused on expanding your wheel skills. Each session will focus on a topic related to developing and adding to your wheel throwing techniques, such as lids, handles and spouts. *This class is intended for students with a strong basic knowledge of throwing.* Tuesday evenings, 6-8 pm.

4 WEEKS CREATING IN CLAY

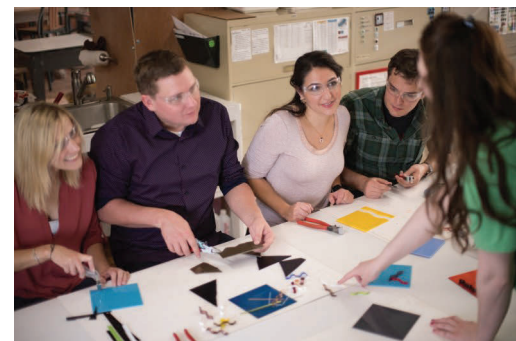
This is a class designed to introduce students to the basics of Hand Building techniques: pinch, slab and coil. This class is for individuals with little to no experience. Wednesday evenings 6-8 pm. This class is only offered sessions: 1,2,5,6.



GLASS FUSING CLASSES

4 WEEKS INTRO TO GLASS FUSING

This is an introductory class in glass fusing. You will learn the fundamentals of glass fusing: cutting glass, laying it out in creative ways, and fusing it together to create unique designs and projects. *No glass experience is required.* Wednesday evenings from 6-8 pm. This class only offered sessions: 1,2,5,6.



GLASS FOR EVERYONE

This is an 8 week class for any level. During the first six weeks we will concentrate on the basics of glass fusing (cutting and firing temperatures) and different techniques of decorating glass while creating small projects. The last two weeks will be for larger projects of your choosing. *No glass experience is required.* Tuesdays or Wednesdays from 10am-12pm.



ADVANCED GLASS

This 8 week class is ideal for students with strong basic fusing skills who are self-motivated and have several projects in mind. New techniques will be introduced such as frit painting and more complex slumping methods. *Fusing and slumping experience is required.* Mondays evenings from 6-8 pm.

SATURDAY EXTENDED DAY SESSIONS

Get ready to have an AWESOME Saturday. These extended classes are one time classes every month.

You will get both group and personal instruction.

Cost is \$35 per person | Classes are from 10:30 am—1:00 pm
