

## **Glass Firing Policy - April 2024**

# **Glass Firing At ICCGS**

Glass firing is available for purchase per square cubic inch per firing to those enrolled in a session.

We offer community firing services for temperature rangesTack Fuse, Full Fuse, and Slump for Systems 96 Glass.

### Cost

<u>Full Fuse</u> - \$.05 per square inch <u>Tack Fuse</u> - \$.05 per square inch

- All firing are for System 96 Glass
- o Each Kiln Shelf is approx 22" in Diameter
- Firing Fee must be paid before firing
- Each piece must be labeled with artist name

### Slump Firing - \$.07 per square inch

- Each piece must be labeled with artist name
- Firing Fee must be paid before firing

#### **Schedule**

Glass Kilns will be loaded and fired as the carts fill up and our schedule allows. Work is typically processed within two weeks.

#### **Damage Fees**

If an individual piece damages a kiln shelf beyond repair the artist will be required to pay the cost of a new shelf for the studio, Glass Kiln Shelf (\$150)

No guarantee is offered, explicit or implied, regarding the quality or serviceability of fired work. Every precaution will be taken to ensure the best possible outcome for every firing. When you submit pieces for firing, you agree that you will not hold the studio, it's staff, volunteers or any other person associated with the studio responsible for work that is damaged or defective in any way while in the studio at any stage of the process.
